ORDINANCE NO. 2025-0303

AN ORDINANCE CANCELING THE MAY 3, 2025 REGULAR CITY OFFICERS ELECTION AND DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Denver City, Texas, is a Home Rule Municipality located in Yoakum County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with law, a general election has been ordered for May 3, 2025, for the purpose of electing a Mayor for a three-year term and two Council members at-large for three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, no proposition is to appear on the ballot in that election; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified in writing that each candidate on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy has passed; and

WHEREAS, in these circumstances Subchapter C of Chapter 2 of the Election Code authorizes a governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the election;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENVER CITY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 3, 2025 general election, are hereby declared elected to office and shall be issued a certificate of election following the time the election would have been canvassed:

Mayor Ronald Weir Councilmember Joan Breith

SECTION 2

The May 3, 2025 general election is canceled, and the City Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this ordinance to be posted on election day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

SECTION 3

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, or to be held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than that part so decided to be invalid or held to be unconstitutional.

SECTION 4

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
