

ORDER APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES AND ALTERNATE JUDGES

BE IT HEREBY ORDERED on motion by Commissioner Marion, seconded by Commissioner Box, and unanimously approved by the Court, that the following Election Judges and Alternate Judges be appointed to serve for a term of two year beginning on August 12, 2024 and ending on August 12, 2026, according to Sec. 32.002(a) (b) of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE, and that the maximum number of clerks to serve at each election precinct be set at 3 (Includes the Alternate Judge and a worker).
