

ORDER SETTING TAX RATE

THE STATE OF TEXAS }
COUNTY OF YOAKUM }

On the 9th day of September, 2019, at a duly posted and advertised public meeting on the Proposed 2020 Budget and 2019 Tax Rate, there is transacted, the following:

It is ORDERED on motion by Commissioner Addison, second by Commissioner Box, and carried with (4) members voting in favor (Addison, Box, Lindsey, and Marion) and (1) voting against (Judge Barron), that the tax rate per \$100 valuation for **tax year 2019** be set as follows:

- \$.547487 Ad Valorem Maintenance and Operation
- .020161 Ad Valorem Interest and Sinking (Debt Service)
- .112435 Farm-Market-Lateral Maintenance and Operation

- \$.680083 Total Tax Rate

“THIS TAX RATE (TOTAL OF \$.680083 PER \$100 VALUATION) WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR’S TAX RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL DECREASE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE ON THE AVERAGE RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD BY APPROXIMATELY \$ 83.00.”




